The 10U battle of Santa Clara produced a full game of excited cheers, anxious gasps and lots of nail biting on both sides as SC Briarwood and SC Westside battled till the bottom of the 6th, when Briarwood's Timothy Stampolis drilled a single up the middle to bring home Sammy Martinez from third for a walk-off 10-9 victory.

Inning one was uneventful on both sides as Briarwood's Timothy Stampolis set down Westside on 12 pitches, only giving up an infield single to Westside's Charles Conley. Mason Gonzalez posted a couple Ks for Westside before Mateo Escobedo and Toby Esqueda each flared singles to right. Mason got Aadit Kolli to line to second to end the 1st inning threat and leave no score after one played.

Zach Kwon, AJ Figueroa and Mason Gonzalez broke through in the top of the 2nd for Westside with a single by Zach, a catcher's interference call on an 0 and 2 pitch for AJ and Mason's 2 RBI single to left. Elijah Gandeza moved Mason to third on a perfect bunt sacrifice for out one. After Matthew Nguyen worked a 3-2 walk, Wilson Peterson put the ball in play for an infield error that saw the ball sail past first base to push both runners home. Timothy got Daniel DeLaCerde to line to 2nd for out 2, then struck out Charles Conley on a 1-2 pitch after Charles got some noise from the crowd when he fouled one down the right field line.

With just a leadoff walk given up but stranded by Mason in the bottom of the 2nd inning, Westside kept a 4-0 lead after 2 complete.

Timothy kept the pressure on Westside with an eight pitch inning in the top of the 3rd, setting down Jake Prettol on a grounder to first, Zach Kwon on a nifty scoop and throw by third baseman Toby Esqueda and a strikeout of Maddy Tamone.

In the bottom of the third, Briarwood's bats found momentum, helped by leadoff walks to Brayden Rosa and Justin Foerster. Mateo Escobedo drilled an RBI single to right to put Briarwood on the scoreboard. After Toby Esqueda was hit by a 1-1 pitch, Westside changed pitchers, bringing Zach Kwon to the mound with bases loaded and no one out.

Zach earned the first out on a hard 3-2 liner to short by Aadit Kolli. But a four pitch walk to Sammy Martinez forced across a run to narrow the score to 4 to 2. Adrian Aguilar earned an RBI with a grounder to third that brought in Briarwood's third run, while the speedy Adrian was safe at first. Timothy Stampolis tied the game with a fielder's choice RBI that he also legged out, keeping the bases full. Gilly Padilla fought off a tricky 3-2 pitch with a slicing grounder to 2nd that brought home Sammy and forced Westside's Elijah to throw to 1st for the 2nd out. Zach maintained pitching composure to end the inning as Brayden drilled a grounder to short that was thrown to 1st for out 3 to keep the game close at Briarwood 5, Westside 4.

Westside threatened in the 4th after Timothy started the inning with a four pitch strikeout of Jaxson Chao. Elijah legged out a single to short and advanced to second on a wild pitch. Kevin Mulquier earned first on a grounder to short that kept Elijah at 2nd. Then in a nine-pitch four-foul battle with Wilson Peterson, Timothy got Wilson to line a hard shot for out two at 2nd baseman Mateo who quickly tossed to first to double off Kevin and end the inning. Score after three and ½: Briarwood 5, Westside 4.

One out singles by Mateo and Toby and a walk to Nicholas Hernandez in the bottom of the 4th put pressure on Westside, but a fly to center by Aadit and a bases loaded grounder by Hilbert Chen to pitcher Zach ended the threat and kept the game at 5 to 4.

Westside pushed Timothy to his 75 pitch limit to start the 5th inning, with three straight singles by Daniel DeLaCerde, Charles Conley and Jake Prettol. Mateo Escobedo took over on the mound with the bases full and nobody out. Zach worked a 3-2 walk to force across a run and tie the game at 5-5. AJ Figueroa was safe on a dropped fly to left field that brought in two runs for a Westside 7-5 lead, still no outs. Mason grounded to Mateo who looked to first but wisely threw to 3rd for the force out. AJ took 3rd on a stolen base and came home alertly on a passed ball to extend the Westside lead to 8-5. An error at first base brought home Mason to stretch the Westside lead further to 9-5. Pitcher Mateo took a few deep breaths and focused to get a strikeout for out number 2 and then a 2-2 grounder to second to end the inning.

With time slipping away for Briarwood in the bottom of the 5th, Timothy Stampolis led off by running out a grounder to 3rd to earn a leadoff single followed by his steal of 2nd base. Isaac Read brought Tim home with a hard-hit ball that induced an error at 2nd, to bring the score to 9-6. An error by the first baseman trying to cut down Isaac at 2nd

allowed Isaac to keep on running, and he circled the bases to bring the score to 9-7. Brayden drilled a grounder to third, and was thrown out at first for out one.

Justin Foerster pounded a 1-0 single to left and advanced to 2nd on a fielding error to bring the tying run to the plate. Mateo grounded to pitcher Zach, just far enough off the mound to force Zach to throw to 1st for out 2, while Justin scooted home to narrow the score to 9-8. Then with the bases empty and 2 outs and a full count, Toby Esqueda ripped the ball to deep right field for a stand-up triple that pushed the crowd on both sides to a frenzy and led to Jake Prettol taking over on the mound for Zach Kwon.

With Toby's tying run just 90 feet away for Briarwood, Jake pitched one just past the reach of catcher Charles Conley and Toby barreled home with a hard slide to tie the game at 9-9 on the wild pitch. Jake regained his focus and struck out Aadit Kolli looking to end the inning and send the game to the 6th all even for both sides at 9 up.

Briarwood reliever Brayden Rosa shut the door on Westside in the top of the 6th, getting a grounder to 3rd from Daniel, a shoetop line drive to 2nd by Charles and a 2-0 grounder to 2nd by Jake.

With the season on the line for both teams, Westside and Briarwood went to the bottom of the 6th tied, Briarwood coming to the plate.

Sammy Martinez heightened the tension by earning a seven-pitch walk to lead off the inning. Andrew Traffas stood in and got a walk as well. Sammy saw an opportunity to take 3rd. The throw was low and on target. The 3rd base umpire called Sammy out and the fans on both sides made noise. Alleging the ball had been dropped before the tag, Briarwood Coach Mark Traffas appealed the play to the home plate umpire who called an umpire conference. After discussion, the umpires reversed the call to send Sammy back to 3rd base, safe after his effort to take 3rd. Two on, no one out. Tie game. Timothy Stampolis to the plate.

Pitch one was down the middle, a bit on the inside of the plate, but not to Timothy's liking. Strike one. Pitch two high and outside. Ball one. The 1-1 pitch came in straight over the plate and Timothy banded it up the middle, over the pitcher's mound, over second base, sending Sammy home from 3rd with the winning run and spurring ecstatic jumping by the Briarwood players and fans before the ball even was retrieved.

An exciting game for both sides. Excellent sportsmanship by the Santa Clara players, many of whom on both teams know each other from years growing up in the same community.
