SC Briarwood shot out of the gates quickly in this game, with Tyson Mitchell scoring on a tough line drive error by the short stop and Alan Ramirez crossing the plate on a Justin Aldor RBI ground out. Ozzy Cadena then pitched the bottom half of the inning and recorded all three outs - 2 by strike outs swinging, and the third on a pop up back to the pitcher. Continuing the top of the second where they left off, the SC Briarwood Pirates plated 5 more runs. Leading off the inning, Seth Ruiz deposited a Liam Barrett fastball in the trees behind the Center Field fence. Livening things up a bit more, Justin Forster beat out a bunt, and a throwing error to first base resulted in the speedy youngster attempting to score, making it safely to third base before being thrown out in a razor-close play at home. Aadit Kolli followed up with a single before Noah Pang reached on an error. Aadit then scored on a Tyson Mitchell ground out before Alan Ramirez knocked out a 2-run home run to Left Field. The final run in the inning came via single by Ozzy Cadena, who advanced on Justin Aldor's single and scored on an error by the left fielder. Unfortunately for Mt. View, the Pirates couldn't solve their problem with Ozzy Cadena in the bottom of the second inning, as the big hurler recorded all three outs via strike outs swinging. SC Briarwood continued the onslaught in their half of the third, with Seth Ruiz hitting a lead-off double and advancing to third after Justin Forster reached on an error by the short stop. Sathvik Yetukuri then plated Seth with a flawlessly executed sacrifice bunt back to the pitcher Liam Barrett, who made a superb play to record the out at first. A wild pitch then allowed Justin to score from third. At this point, Mt. View's manager brought in Wesley Kenyon to relieve Liam Barrett on the mound, and Wesley immediately struck out SC Briarwood's Ozzy Cadena swinging to end the top half of the inning. Mt. View was quiet again in their half of the third, with Ozzy Cadena recording a strike out against the only batter he faced that inning. Alan Ramirez then came on in relief, striking out one batter before Christian Bandy reached on an error by SC Briarwood's short stop. Mt. View couldn't get anything going, though, as Liam Barrett grounded out to first base to end the inning. Mt. View then put together their best defensive inning of the game: Justin Aldor started the action with a double, and reached third on a 6-3 ground out by Nikhil Somanchi. Seth Ruiz then hit into a 1-3-2 double-play to end the inning, with the play at home again being razor close. Down 9-0 in the bottom of

the fourth, Mt. View finally got their bats going, with Wesley Kenyon starting things off with a single, followed by Aaron Beer's smash home run into the trees beyond Left Field. The euphoria was short-lived, however, as a 6-3 ground out and 2 strike outs left Eero Lee stranded on first after being hit by an Alan Ramirez fastball. SC Briarwood then turned up the heat in the top half of the fifth inning. Justin Forster led off with a single and advanced to second following a walk to Sathvik Yetukuri. Noah Pang then plated Justin with a double, and Mt. View loaded the bases with a walk to Tyson Mitchell. SC Briarwood then scored on a walk to Alan Ramirez. Mt. View reached back into its bull pen once again and brought in Ethan Guilhamet to replace Wesley. Ethan immediately struck out SC Briarwood's Ozzy Cadena, and in a nifty double play, Mt. View threw out Noah Pang 2-3-1 as he attempted to score on the dropped third strike to Ozzy. Unfortunately for Mt. View, SC Briarwood kept their motors running, with Justin Aldor reaching on a single to score Tyson Mitchell before Nikhil Somanchi tripled, pushing Alan Ramirez and Justin across the plate. Seth Ruiz was then intentionally walked, and Ethan Guilhamet ended the damage by striking out Justin Forster swinging. In Mt. View's half of the fifth inning, Ethan grounded out to the second baseman before Christian Bandy was hit by a high-and-tight Seth Ruiz fastball. Liam Barret then flied out to deep left field, and Wesley Kenyon ended the game with a line out to first base. Final Score: SC Briarwood 14, Mt. View 2.
