After an error to lead off the inning, consecutive singles by Louie Miranda-Ortiz and Noah Robbins followed by a walk and an error, lead to Santa Clara Westside plating 5 runs in the inning. Sunnyvale National battled back in the top of the third pushing across 4 runs, with 2 walks and 3 hits in the inning, to tie the score at 5. Santa Clara Westside kept the pressure on in the bottom of the third pushing across another 5 runs on three hits and 3 errors to take a 10-5 lead. Sunnyvale National pushed across a run in the top of the fourth to get closer but still trailed 10-6 headed to the fifth. Santa Clara Westside put the game out of reach with a double and 2 singles along with 3 errors, to push across another 5 runs. Sunnyvale National went down in order in the top of the 6th, and Santa Clara Westside came away with the victory 15-6.

It was an unusually cool and windy June day at Purissima Park in Los Altos Hills where the Mountain View Giants squared-off against the Santa Clara Briarwood Tigers in a District 44 Minors Tournament of Champions game. Both the Tigers and the Giants received outstanding efforts from their starting pitchers. Briarwood's #6 Danny O. threw 75 pitches over 4.0 innings while striking out 6 Giants. Mountain View cashed-in with 3.1 innings from #3 S. Cash, who also threw over 70 pitches and 4Ks. However, neither pitcher factored in the W/L decision.

Mountain View jumped-off to a great start with a 3-run top of the 1st when #8 G. Murdock reached with a 2-out single. After Murdock stole 2B, his brother #10 E. Murdock rocked an RBI single and advanced to 2B on the throw. Then #9 A. Xu's first 2B of the evening plated E. Murdock. Xu then used his speed to steal third and to score on a passed ball.

Mountain View held a 5-2 lead going into the bottom of the 3rd when Briarwood's lead-off hitter #1 Gilbert P. drew a walk and advanced to 2B on a passed ball. He then scored on #12 Adrian A.'s RBI double. Adrian A. also scored on a groundout cutting Mountain View's lead to 5-4.

Briarwood's momentum continued into the bottom of the 4th inning when the Tigers manufactured four walks sandwiched around a 2-run error and a RBI single by #6 Danny O. As a result, Briarwood took a 9-5 lead into the top of the 5th.

After Briarwood's pitcher #6 Danny O. left the game in the 5th inning, Mountain View brought seven batters to the plate and scored the maximum 5-runs per inning allowed in the TOC. The highlight was a 3-run 2B by #9 A. Xu, his 2nd of the night. The big inning pushed Mountain View back into the lead 10-9.

Briarwood's bottom of the 5th started-off with a clutch single by #4 Nico O. Then, #10 Sohan K. worked a 1-out walk allowing the go-ahead run to move to first base. Tiger slugger #17 Michael V. then stepped up to the plate and proceeded to knock a hard single into centerfield scoring #4 Nico O. and forcing a fielding error that also scored #10 Sohan K.

The 11-10 lead held-up in the top of the 6th inning as Tiger relief pitcher #5 Timmy S. struck-out the first batter and then induced back-to-back groundouts to finish the game.
