

## 2019 CA D44 Minors TOC Game Summaries

#### Minors TOC Championship Game

Mountain View Pirates v. Campbell Rays played at Moreland Little League Majors Field.

Campbell took a dominant lead by taking the first inning by the 5 run max rule. Mountain View pitcher Logan Trifunovich pitched great, but Campbell's batters kept answering with hard line drives down the third base line.

In the third inning Mountain View began to rally with three runs scored. But Campbell's turn at bat proved too much this time, with Blake Orr sending the ball high and far over centerfield, earning a double and two RBI's. Aiden Swartz then substituted in to pitch and got the needed outs. But Mountain View's turn at bat resulted in zero additional runs. Campbell led the third with 12 runs.

At the top of the fourth, Philip Chen pitched for Mountain View. Second baseman Aden Schwartz caught the first hit for an out and right fielder Ryan Jhin caught the second hit. The third out came from a nice through from Schwartz to first base.

Bottom of the fourth with Orr still pitching for Campbell, Ashton Racicot hit a double, earning an RBI. Racicot then stole third base and ultimately scoring on a hit Cal Lau. After Mountain View scores three additional runs, Dominic Trinidad came in to pitch for Campbell and helped get the third out.

Campbell finished the top of the fifth inning with 14 runs and then quickly got three defensive outs leaving Mountain View with the same 6 runs

Sixth a final inning was an opening inning. Campbell ended the top with 19 runs. Despite Mountain View having bases loaded with Ryan Jhin hitting a single and scoring two RBI's, the Campbell Rays defense held Mountain View to a total of 9 runs.

Game 5 of the D44 Minors TOC Baseball game was played on Wednesday 6/12 at Wilson Park in Cupertino.

Game 5 consisted of home team Campbell Rays vs the visiting team Santa Clara Westside Mets. Hosting the game was Cupertino Little League.

Starting pitcher for Campbell was Roman S. Lead-off batter Kalani Tesimale singles to SS for a base hit. Next batter Ricky Barrientos grounds to SS forcing a fielder's choice with Kalani out on the advance to 2nd base. Ricky advances to 3rd on singles by Gio Dominquez and Ian Eckland. Ricky scores from an error by first baseman. Campbell pitcher Roman S. strikes out next two batters to end the top of the 1st.

Starting pitcher for Westside was Ian Eckland. Ian starts out strong allowing no hits in the 1st and 2nd innings retiring 6 batters including 3 of which were strikeouts.

On the Campbell pitching side, Roman S's continues his strong pitching streak in the 2nd and 3rd innings. Out of 11 at bats, Roman allows only 2 singles while closing down 9 with excellent defense by all infielders, notably, 2nd baseman Lucas Salinas, short stop Chase Rich and 3rd baseman Dominic Trinidad.

Campbell Rays scored 5 in the 3rd inning mostly on walks and a double by Roman S, as Westside pitcher Gio Dominguez struggled on the mound.

Westside Mets had a strong push in the top of the 5th scoring 4 runs by singles from Kalani Tesimale, Adrian Chavez, Jack Eden, Mitchell Perry and a double by Ryan Pham.

Despite the push, Campbell Rays had their own hitting streak with multiple singles and a double in the 4th and 5th to end the game 15 to 5.
