In the bottom of the 3rd inning, SC Briarwood held Cupertino at 12 runs on a heads-up double play by short-stop **Ian Denny**.

Adam Cheung held SC Briarwood to 3 runs in the top of the fourth, with help from his short stop **Tyrone Tan**, who made a spectacular catch in shallow left field, near the third baseline. In the bottom of the fourth, **Isaac Chong** singled to right field. Sunnyvale sent Tung and McCray from the bullpen in relief of Rosner. But Metro came roaring back in the fourth inning with three runs of their own to take the lead back, 7-5. Metro's **Matthew Miller** and **Ettan Mishra** both crossed the plate on heads-up baserunning, and Bokla drew a bases-loaded walk, scoring **Justin Miller**. On defense, Bokla made two dazzling catches in left field to keep the game close.

In the fifth inning, Donahue led off once again and reached safely on a double; he would later score on a passed ball, trimming Metro's lead 7-6. Donahue found his pitching rhythm in the fifth and sixth innings, retiring the Metro batters in order 1-2-3. **Tyler Owen** caught all four Sunnyvale pitchers.

With Sunnyvale down by one run in the bottom of the sixth, they put two runners on base by virtue of a walk and a single. This set the stage for **Trevor Uyehara**, who completed Sunnyvale's comeback with a walk-off double to right field, scoring both runners.
